

Bully Pair Share

Time needed: 20 minutes

Recommended Level: All grades

Categories: Awareness

Common Core Standard (s): Speaking & Listening

Purpose: Students will understand where bullying often takes place and what they should do about it.

DISCUSSION:

Guide a classroom discussion on places where bullying often happens outside the classroom – lunchroom, hallways, online, recess, etc.)

ACTIVITY:

Have students get in pairs.

Roll a dice or pull a popsicle stick, etc. to choose a location. Pairs will then discuss bullying situations that they have witnessed or experienced in their area.

Students will have 3-5 minutes to discuss. Then, they will switch partners. (One method is to have half the class sit in their assigned seats, then to have the other students rotate around them clockwise.)

Roll the dice again to pick a new location. Students will discuss.

Repeat until time is up or until all locations have been covered.

FOLLOW-UP:

In class discussion, ask students to give examples that they had shared with a partner.
