Pacer Kids Games and Activities

Time needed: 5 - 30 minutes **Recommended Level:** Grades PK-4

Categories: Bystanders, Helping victims, Reporting, Role-playing Common Core Standard(s): ELA: Reading literature, Writing, Speaking & Listening, Understanding perspectives and culture Purpose: Students identify how characters are bullies or are being bullied. They solve how to react to the bully.

DISCUSSION:

Go to the website (or have students go to the website if they have their own computers):

Familiarize studenst with the website.

Choose "Kids Say" on the top menu, then click "Ask Sally." Read each of the children's tales

ACTIVITY:

Each "Dear Sally" entry ends with a question. Have students write their answers to the questions presented at the end of each tale.

Each story is followed with advice from the "crew" on the website. Have students volunteer to share their answers with the class, and compare these answers with the ones provided by the "crew."

FOLLOW-UP:

- Other website activities: The Pacer Kids website contains other educational games and activities. If students have an individual computer, encourage them to explore the website.
- Poster/collage: Have students cut out magazine pictures
 of people being bullies or pictures of people helping each
 other. Older students can write a caption under the picture
 explaining it. Have students compile their pictures together
 on a large poster which can be displayed in the classroom or
 hallway.
