

Report It!

Time needed: Varies

Recommended Level: Grade 5-8

Categories: Reporting

Common Core Standard(s): Speaking & Listening,
Writing to convey information

Purpose: Students will help create a safe
and anonymous way to report bullying.

DISCUSSION:

This project should take place under the direction of school administrators.

Explain to students that they will be assigned to teams. The team's job is to design and implement a system for safe, anonymous bullying reporting.

The team may choose to create this system in a variety of ways depending on school needs and resources (online, paper, but all teams must create a system where bullying is reported anonymously.)

ACTIVITY:

Give students time to develop and submit their ideas. Choose a winning team and use their ideas to create an anonymous bullying reporting system at your school. A successful system will have a qualified person to monitor the system as well as a person with whom students can meet face-to-face or electronically.

FOLLOW-UP:

Continue to monitor the system. You can conduct a survey of the staff and students to see how to make the program more effective as the school year goes on.
