

School-Wide Bullying Assemblies

Time needed: 30 min. classroom time, 10 min. for assembly

Recommended Level: All grades

Categories: Awareness, Role playing

Common Core Standard (s): Understanding perspectives and culture, Speaking & Listening

Purpose: Students will present scenarios on bullying and act them out to learn correct responses.

DISCUSSION:

Discuss with the class types of bullying that occur at school.

ACTIVITY:

After brainstorming the types of bullying that occur at the students' school, the class will pick one to present to the entire school. The class will be divided into two groups. One group will show the situation in the negative. The second group will present the situation showing the correct response to the situation.

FOLLOW-UP:

Each homeroom teacher will discuss the scenarios in their homerooms. What was the situation? What was the incorrect way to handle the situation? How could you have handled this better?

If your school would prefer not to do this as a full school assembly, you may be able to partner with teachers at your grade level, teachers at your end of the hallway, or even just in your classroom.
