

School-Wide Slogan Contest

Time needed: 20 minutes

Recommended Level: All grades

Categories: Awareness, Empowering

Common Core Standard (s): Writing creatively

Purpose: Students will create anti-bullying slogans.

DISCUSSION:

Teacher will model one possible slogan for the students to see, "Bully Free and Proud."

ACTIVITY:

Students will create their own slogans either individually or in groups.

Students will share their slogans with the class.

FOLLOW-UP:

Have the school administration pick its top 3 choices for slogans. The students will then be allowed to vote for the one they like best. The one that has the most votes wins and will be used daily in the morning announcements.
